

Rules of Play

- Entries accompanied by the full entry fees must reach the Tournament Organisers by Wednesday 21/05/2025. Please make payment out to WCBF Aust Div. by direct deposit: St George Bank, BSB 112-879, Account 447648031 as a team by the captain with the team's name as reference.
- **2.** Players must wear appropriate badminton attire, including non-marking shoes, when on court and at all times in the hall or they will risk disqualification.
- 3. All players must be at the hall at least 15 minutes prior to the start of their event.
- **4.** Start times may be varied and should be confirmed with the organisers the day before the tournament.
- **5.** Any player without a team who wants to participate, please submit their names and contact details on the entry form. The player will be put into teams that are incomplete and their entry fee is payable to the adopted team.
- **6.** Players participating in the tournament play at their own risk and organisers are not liable for any claims of any kind.
- **7.** The Tournament Committee reserves the right to cancel any event if insufficient numbers of entries are received.
- **8.** Each grade is limited to a maximum number of teams. Once the maximum number of teams in a grade has been received, the next team submitted will be on the waiting list.
- **9.** The Tournament will comply with the rules and regulations laid down by the Badminton World Federation (BWF).
- **10.** The team named first in the draw will umpire the first game, thereafter teams alternate the umpiring.
- Players name & age to be based on their passport or driver's license e.g. year born 1961 (2021 – 1961 = 60 years old).

Match Structure

- Consists of 5 games Each man will play either 1 Men's Doubles and 1 Mixed Doubles, or 2 Men's Doubles. Both ladies will play Ladies Doubles and a Mixed Doubles. Each of the five players can only play a maximum of 2 events each.
- Team captains will work out the pairing combinations with their members. Pairing combinations can be changed but the order of merit must be maintained. 1st man will play in the first mixed doubles.
- Each Team will play every other Team within its Group in the match schedule.
- Each match has 5 rubbers with 2 games of 21 points each no settings.
- Each match will be 2.0 hours in duration. It will commence at the scheduled time and cease promptly when the bell is sounded. See Scoring System.
- Player warm-up time is also included in the 2.0 hours. No extra time will be allowed.

Scoring System

- 2 match points will be awarded to the team scoring the greater number of points in a match.
- If points are equal, the team winning more games will be the winner of the match. If the games won by the teams are equal then one match point will be awarded to each team.
- The team in each group with the greatest number of match points will be the winner.
- At the sound of the finishing bell (end of 2.0 hours), all games must stop and the number of points recorded even the game is unfinished.
- If a player is injured or becomes ill during a game and is unable to continue, the opposing team will be rewarded a forfeit for that game (maximum points 21). However the team in forfeit will retain all points scored. A substitute for subsequent games is allowed only after that game is finished.
